In some instances, pricing details may be mentioned in the charger's description. Please note that pricing information may not be accessible for certain locations.

Click on a specific charging station pin on the map and look for information about the types of connectors available. If it's Tesla-compatible, it should list Tesla-specific connectors. You may also find information in the reviews and comments on the location.

A station's score reflects the experience of users on a scale of 1 to 10, with 10 being the highest score. When a user reports a negative experience at a charging station, its score drops. When a user reports a positive experience, the station's score rises. A neutral comment or check-in does not affect the overall score. It is also worthwhile reading the comments on each location to get more insights into the reason behind each score. You can view PlugScores from the Station Summary icon on the map.

Potential EV Day Trips from Havana, Cuba One of the most popular driving destinations from Havana is Varadero, a resort town known for its beautiful beaches. It is approximately 145 km east of Havana, making it a perfect day trip for electric vehicle (EV) drivers. The journey offers scenic views of the Cuban countryside and coastline. Varadero also has several EV charging stations, ensuring that your car won't run out of power. Besides the stunning beaches, you can also visit the Varadero Street Market, the Ambrosio Cave, and the Varahicacos Ecological Reserve.

Another interesting destination is Viñales, located about 180 km west of Havana. Famous for its tobacco farms and limestone cliffs, Viñales offers a unique look into rural Cuban life. The journey to Viñales is a treat for nature lovers, with lush green landscapes and the Sierra de los Organos mountain range. Although charging



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stations are less common here than in Varadero, careful planning and conservative driving can make the trip possible for EV users. In Viñales, don't miss the chance to visit the Viñales Valley, the Prehistoric Mural, and the Palenque de los Cimarrones.

Note these are suggestions only; please ensure you check the charging infrastructure prior to your journey.

Before the end of 2023, the Cuban Ministry of Transportation plans to place photovoltaic solar energy stations to charge electric vehicles in airport, bus and train terminals, through the project named Tecxol.
