Firstly, you will need to check whether your property is served by mains electricity. Your supplier can tell you this, and explain how to apply for a connection. Most electricity boards allow you to do this online. You can also ask your electrical installation engineer to do it for you.

For 2024, electricity prices in Spain are expected to undergo some changes, starting with phasing out tax rebates. During 2023, the average electricity bill for households on the regulated tariff (PVPC) was EUR60.26 per month (EUR723 per year), representing a significant reduction compared to previous years.

Pole numbers, not house or business addresses ensure quick remedial action in time of accident or emergency.
