BRUNEI ECONOMIC OUTLOOK 2024 Summary The Brunei economy grew in 2023 after two consecutive years of contractions. GDP expanded by an impressive 1.4 percent in 2023, the second fastest annual growth rate in the past decade (Figure 1). This is however lower than the 2.6 percent growth forecasted in the Brunei Economic Outlook

Despite economic and legal changes now under way, Brunei Darussalam remains well positioned to continue on its current trajectory of steady economic growth and political stability. The increasing focus on economic diversification, and the ongoing growth of the non-energy sectors, bodes well for the Bruneian economy, as does further exploration ...

Despite repeated calls for diversification, Brunei's economy remains overwhelmingly dependent on the income derived from the sale of oil and gas and downstream products, which represents 80 percent of Brunei's total exports and 53.5 percent of the country's GDP.

Brunei Darussalam has started strengthening the 5 priority sectors, downstream oil and gas industries, food, services, tourism, and information and communication technology, which are expected to increase future revenue outside of the upstream oil and gas industry.
