Outdoor solar lights can light up your walkway, backyard, or porch without the need to find an electrical outlet or worry about running low on battery. But finding the right solar lights for you can depend on several factors, as well as your budget. Solar lights typically stake into the ground, although there are also options for solar touch lights, wall-mounted lights, string lights, and more. Depending on the quantity and type of solar lights you're looking at, they can cost anywhere between \$20 and over \$200.

After examining several of the top solar light options on the market, our choice for the best outdoor solar lights is the Linkind Smart Solar Lights, which provide a wide variety of preset lighting options and specialty modes and can even be paired with music. Read our guide below for more of our top picks.

When I tested these solar lights, I found installation to be pretty straightforward, and they easily staked into the ground in my backyard. After letting them charge during the day, I was happy to see all of the lights had a full charge in the evening despite my backyard being relatively shady.

Without downloading the AiDot app, you can still set these lights to several different singular colors by clicking a button on the bottom of each light. However, downloading the app allowed me to control each light right from my phone or set them as a group. The app took a few minutes to connect, but once I got the lights set up, I was very impressed with the amount of options available and how easy it was to change.

The brightness level can be adjusted right from your smartphone from 0 to 100%. I found these lights to be pretty bright when put on the highest setting, although I do feel they all need to be used together to get enough lighting. Regardless, when all six were going at once, it provided plenty of shine in my backyard, and they were effective when facing both outwards towards the woods or pointing directly at the house. I also really liked that you could adjust these lights from the app to determine whether you wanted them to turn on by motion, be left on all day, or automatically be turned on at dusk.

Customers who gave this product a positive review liked the variety of color modes and options as well as its straightforward installation and durable, well-crafted design. However, there were a few negative reviews that pairing these lights on the app was somewhat challenging, and others felt the range was lacking, noting they couldn't adjust the lights while inside.

Satisfied customers said that the torches were sturdy and easy to assemble. Many also said that friends and neighbors mistook the lights for genuine flames. Nearly all negative reviews feature complaints about the lights malfunctioning over time.

? Has a lifespan of 20,000 hours? Built with WeatherTite technology, allowing the bulbs to withstand snow and winds? Includes 12 replacement bulbs for when the others burn out
